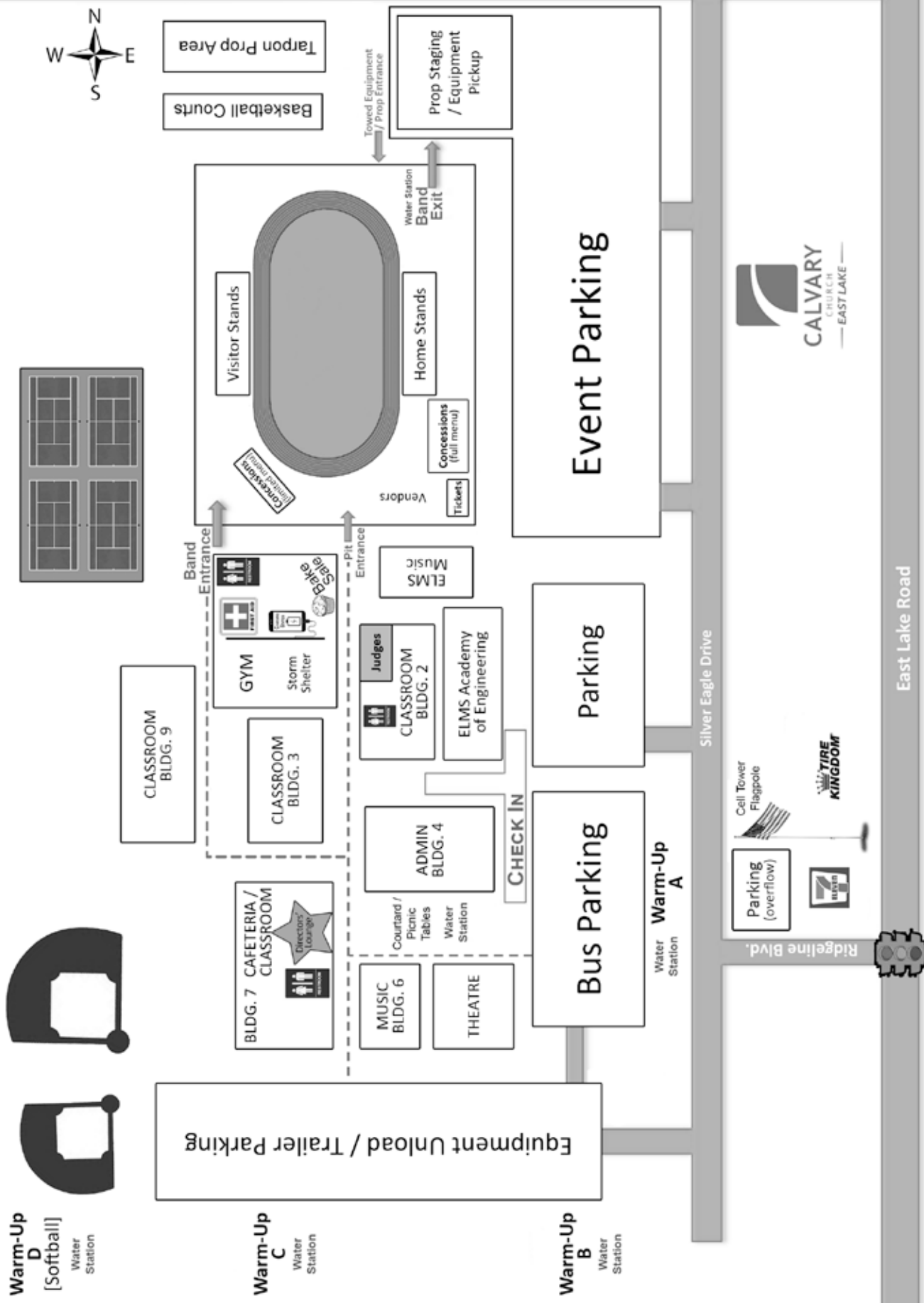

MEET THE JUDGES

Chris Creswell

Chris is an accomplished trombonist, composer, visual designer, and educator currently living in his hometown of Jacksonville. Chris has enjoyed the privilege of performing and recording with many of today's top pop and jazz artists including Mariah Carey, John Pizzarelli, Maceo Parker, Tom Kubis, Will Smith, Arturo Sandoval, and many more. For the past 20 years Chris has written marching band drill design, custom arrangements, and original compositions for high school and college bands across the United States as well as being a staff designer for Marching Show Concepts. His teaching career includes directing bands at The Orange County High School of the Arts in Santa Ana, CA (2000-2005), Orange Park High School in Orange Park, FL (2005-2008) and Fleming Island High School in Fleming Island, FL (2009-2012). Since 2012 Chris has been serving as Artist in Residence and Director of Athletic Bands at Jacksonville University.

Chris is a graduate of the University of North Florida and The Manhattan School of Music in New York City where he received his BM and MM degrees respectively in trombone performance and jazz studies. Chris is currently ABD in pursuit of his DMA in Music Education at Boston University where he is researching band director group identity and well-being. Chris is an alumni of the Disney All American College Band, The Epcot Grammy Collegiate Jazz Ensemble, and The Henry Mancini Institute. Chris is a member of the American Society of Composers, Arrangers, and Publishers (ASCAP) and the College Band Directors National Association (CBDNA).

Kevin Griner

Kevin studied Business Management and Marketing at The University of North Florida. He has served as an entertainment performer and stage manager for the Walt Disney Company for over 24 years. Kevin wrote and created the Auxiliary workshop "Auxiliration" for Disney's Magic Music Days; he was also responsible for hiring and training all color guard clinicians for the workshop.

Kevin is a color guard adjudicator for Heritage Festivals, OrlandoFest, and Festival Disney Music competitions. He is also a color guard adjudicator for the Florida Bandmasters Association and a winter guard equipment judge for the Florida Federation of Judges Association. Kevin serves as Color Guard Director for the University of Central Florida Marching Knights and WGI Open Class Gold Medalist Pegasus Winter Guard. He is a sought-after color guard director and designer. He was a member of the Bronze Medal Winning Alliance of Miami Winter Guard in 1991 as well as a 25-year member and instructor in Winter Guard International and Drum Corps International.

Jennifer Miles

Jennifer Miles resides in Tampa, Florida where she is in her eighth year teaching elementary music in Hillsborough County. Jennifer graduated from The University of North Florida with a degree in Music Education and has an extensive performance background in the drum corps activity. She performed with the Kiwanis Cavaliers (2003), Spirit Drum and Bugle Corps (2004-2007), and the Phantom Regiment (2008-2009). Previously she worked as a guest visual/brass technician with OLA high school, Atlanta, GA (2014-2016). Jennifer has traveled to Tocancipa, Colombia as a guest clinician for their annual music festival, as well as Guatemala City as a clinician to the Buhos Marching Band. Currently Jennifer is serving in her sixth year as the visual caption head and high brass instructor with the Wiregrass Ranch Marching Band.

Pat Miller

Pat has been involved in the world of the pageantry arts for over 30 years as an educator, designer, adjudicator, clinician and consultant. Originally starting his career as a performer with the Garfield Cadets, Pat has served in many roles including drill designer, visual caption head, instructor and consultant for several DCI, BOA, and scholastic championship programs. Pat's involvement has included such outstanding DCI organizations as The Cadets (1988-90, 1995), The Glassmen (1997-2012, drill writer 2003, 2004, and 2012), The Blue Knights (1992-93, 2013-14), The Phantom Regiment (2015), The Troopers (2017-19, drill writer 2018), and Louisiana Stars (drill writer 2019-present).

Scholastically, Pat has been instrumental in achieving multiple state championships in Virginia and Florida, and has been involved with Lassiter High School (GA), Center Grove High School (IN), Plymouth Canton (MI), Thomas Jefferson High School of Science and Technology (VA), and is currently the Visual Coordinator and Designer for the Braden River High School Marching Band, the four-time class 3A FMBC Florida State Champions.

Pat is the Director and Visual Designer of Horizon Winds, an Independent Open Class WGI Winds group out of Auburndale, Florida. Formed in 2017, Horizon Winds were the 2017 WGI A Class Silver Medalists and 2018 WGI Open Class Silver Medalists.

Pat is an active adjudicator throughout the Southeast and Midwest and has been a guest conductor at the University of Georgia Middle School Honor Band Festival in Athens, GA. Pat earned his Music Education degree from George Mason University and is currently in his fifteenth year as the Director of Bands at The Out-of-Door Academy, a preK-12 independent college preparatory school in Sarasota, FL. Pat enjoys spending time with his wife while they try to figure out what to do with themselves now that their daughters are both off at college.



MEET THE JUDGES

R. Allan Murray

Allan Murray began his music career at six as a percussionist in the Stratford Boys Band, London Midlanders and the Toronto Optimists Drum and Bugle corps before moving on to California to play snare drum in the Anaheim Kingsmen. Al graduated from Humber College in Toronto, Ontario and studied music at the University of South Florida. Al taught and/or arranged for such drum and bugle corps as the 1975 Oakland Crusaders, 1976-77 Seneca Optimists, 1978 Spirit of Atlanta, 1982-86 Suncoast Sound, 1989-91 and 1998-99 Boston Crusaders, the 1999-2001 Pioneer, the 1994 Magic of Orlando and the undefeated 1994 Empire Statesmen. Internationally Allan has taught clinics in China, Canada, United States, Japan, South Africa, Indonesia, France, the Netherlands, Belgium and Germany. Allan was a music arranger and Director of Distribution Operations for Columbia Pictures Music Publications (now Warner Bros. Music Publications) in Miami, Florida for 10 years. On April 1, 1998 he joined DEG Music Products, Inc. as their new Dynasty USA product line manager responsible for all sales, marketing, research and design of marching brass, bugles and percussion and he was promoted to Vice President, Sales and Marketing for Dynasty USA/ DEG Music Products, Inc., in 2002. Al began work with System Blue in 2009 before becoming the Director of Educational Percussion for Ludwig-Musser, a division of Conn-Selmer, Inc. Allan is now Chief Operating Officer for System Blue based in Concord, CA.

Al has been involved as a performer, arranger, composer, clinician, and adjudicator in the marching music activity for 59 years. Today Al lives in Sebastian, FL.



Ben Norman

Ben is in his seventeenth year as a music educator and has served the past fourteen in Florida's public schools. He received his degree in music education (emphasis in percussion) from Jacksonville University. He is a multi-faceted musician whose interests encompass both instrumental and vocal music performance and pedagogy. He is an active adjudicator for the Florida Federation of Color Guard Circuit, Florida Marching Band Championships, Gulf States Color Guard and Percussion Circuit, USBANDS and various independent shows around the country. He currently teaches at Fleming Island High School in Fleming Island, Florida. His professional associations include: National Association for Music Education, Florida Music Educators Association, The Florida Vocal Association, and the Percussive Arts Society. He is an active member of the Jacksonville Symphony Chorus, a reserve member of the Jacksonville Wind Symphony and freelances as a percussionist as often as time allows. Ben and his wife, Shelly, have one daughter, Taylor, and make their home in Jacksonville.

Herman Rios

Herman is currently the Color Guard Director with Riverview Band Program. As director, Mr. Rios oversees the Color Guard Program's staff and two ensembles—the Blue Radiance Color Guard and the Blue Radiance Winter Guard.

Mr. Rios began his color guard career in 1987 as a member of St. Peter's Color Guard from Dorchester, Massachusetts. Although he was only seven years old at the time, he discovered something he loved and would spend the rest of his life doing. Mr. Rios was also a member of several other local color guards: St. Patrick's of Stoneham, Massachusetts; Karizma of Lynn, Massachusetts; St. John's Productions; Emerald Marquis and St. Ann's. Mr. Rios also has drum corps experience marching with East Coast Jazz and The Cadets.

Mr. Rios has taught several nationally competitive programs throughout the country including Ponderosa High School, Pomona High School, West Boca High School, Florida International University, Braddock Independent and Salem Blue Visual Ensemble. Mr. Rios has also been a member of the design team for XY by Horizon, an all-male color guard under the umbrella of Horizon Performing Arts Association.

Dr. Michael Robinson

Dr. Michael C. Robinson serves as Professor of Music and Director of The Sudler Trophy Award winning Redcoat Marching Band at the University of Georgia. His duties include teaching courses in music education and conducting as well as conducting the Symphonic Band and directing the 440 member Redcoat Marching Band. A native of Florida, Robinson received the B.M. and M.M. degrees in Music Education and the D.M.A. degree in Instrumental Conducting from the University of Miami. Prior to this appointment, he served as Associate Director of Bands at the University of South Florida in Tampa and Director of Bands at Fort Hays State University in Kansas. Robinson also taught eleven years in the public schools of Florida, most notably as Director of Bands at Seminole High School in Pinellas County Florida. During his teaching career, Robinson has received numerous honors and awards including; Pinellas County Teacher of the Year, City of Seminole Educator of the Year, USF College of Visual and Performing Arts Outstanding Service Award, The Orpheus Award from Phi Mu Alpha, and The Friend of the Arts award from Sigma Alpha Iota, among others. Robinson is active as a guest conductor, clinician and adjudicator throughout the United States. He also has extensive experience in the marching arts having served in a variety of capacities with top DCI Drum and Bugle corps such as the Boston Crusaders, The Cadets, Carolina Crown, Iowa Colts, Madison Scouts, and Suncoast Sound.

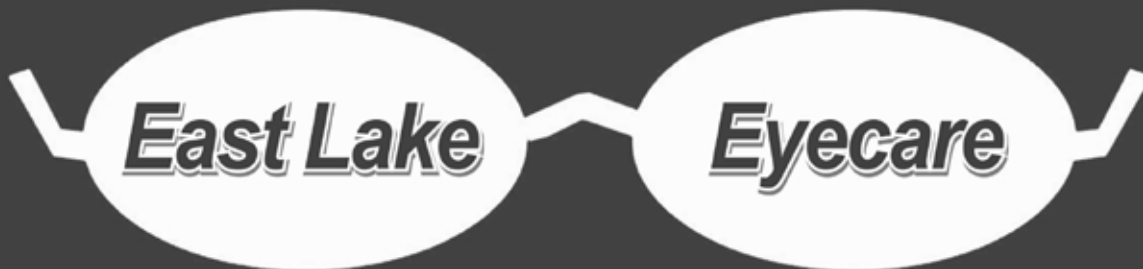
